Methamphetamine (Meth) Labs

Could you spot one in your neighborhood? While no methamphetamine labs have been found in Campbell County, it is important for citizens to be aware of the signs that one may exist. The main ingredient in the production of methamphetamines is propane. The propane tanks will have bluish/green valves with a strong ammonia smell emitting from them. Also necessary are: large quantities of mason jars, acetone cans, empty cold medicine boxes, towels, coffee filters, and plastic containers with different color liquids or solids. These items are considered extremely hazardous. Please contact the police immediately if these items are discovered or if you suspect illegal drug activity in your neighborhood.

Good Neighbor Award

The award was instituted to acknowledge extraordinary acts of kindness by or for our residents.
